## 1 Get in touch

## 2 Upload

We'll then set you up with a Contribute Key, giving you access to a secure part of the site. From here, you can upload files for us to look at.

## 3 Basic Check

Once you have uploaded files, we'll decide how we might use them. For example, we might put together a collection of essays for a specific text in Higher English.

We will let you know about our plans, and might ask you to make some changes, or provide us with additional information.

## 4 Teacher Review

Before your contribution can be added to the site, we want to make sure it's as good as possible. To do this, we send it to a teacher with experience in that subject.

The teacher will probably suggest some changes, and we'll let you know about any important ones.

## 5 Formatting

As you probably know, all the notes on HSN.uk.net have a consistent style. We will spend some time putting your contribution into the HSN style, and incorporating the teacher's suggestions.

## 6 Re-Review

Your contribution is nearly ready to be released now.

To make sure nothing went wrong during formatting, we'll send it off to the teacher again. Once they're happy with it, we'll let you know

## 7 Release

Finally, the best bit – your contribution goes live on HSN.uk.net, where it will help hundreds of students across the country.
